

SAFETRAN Flagger Certification Course

California now requires Flaggers to be trained <u>before</u> flagging traffic on a public street



Information: The SAFETRAN Flagger Training is a 4-hour course which conforms to CCR Title 8, Section 1599. This course includes guided professional instruction on how to safely flag vehicular traffic and how to set up a legal flagger station.

Schedule/Topics Covered: SAFETRAN will provide your employees with a California based Flagger Certification Training based upon Cal-OSHA Title 8 CSO; the class will include all of the following training aspects:

- Introduction to Traffic Safety Overview of OSHA regulations Cal/OSHA regulations Special Clothing & PPE Night Operations Workzone Hazards Temporary Traffic Control Plan (TTCP) Flagger Characteristics Flagger Equipment Signs, Channelizing Devices
- Work Zone Layout Flagger Station Flagger Hand Signals Traffic Control Techniques Special Personal Gear Emergency Evacuation Emergency Vehicles Violations Traffic Accidents Hostile Drivers

Course Materials: Each student will receive a SAFETRAN Flagger Manual

The class: Scope includes a 25-question multiple choice written exam and Flagging demonstration (by instructor). Students will receive a Flagger Card at the completion of training (upon passing the exam).

Instructor: This seminar is taught by Daniel J. O'Connell, CSP, CIT, CHMM, CHST, CHCM, REA Certified Safety Professional Flagger Instructor and Traffic Control Supervisor.
